



## ► Tasiilaq

Experience the unique flavor of East Greenland. Tasiilaq is the largest town in East Greenland with a population of around 1,700. The town is beautifully situated in a fjord surrounded by high mountains. Only about 100 years has passed since the first Europeans arrived in the area, so traditional Inuit culture still has an important role to play in everyday life. But Tasiilaq is also a modern community with all the facilities found elsewhere in the world.

**Please note that Destination East Greenland charges a handling fee of USD 500 to organize excursions here, regardless of participation. This fee is non refundable.**

### Facts

**Location:** 65°36'N / 37°05'W

**Ice condition:** Ice free July-October. Glacier ice likely.

**Pier:** Atlantic Quay. Length 30 m, depth 8,7 m

**Safe anchorage:** 65°36'09"N / 37°33'03"W

**Tender point:** Good pontoon next to Atlantic quay and close to the museum.

**Recommended duration of call:** 4-6 hrs.



### Town walk incl. museum:

A guided walk through the town of Tasiilaq, where you learn about life in East Greenland.

## ► Kangerlussuaq

Kangerlussuaq was originally established as an American base during WW 2. The Americans left the base in 1992 and sold the entire base to the Greenlandic government at the nominal price of 1 US dollar. Today Kangerlussuaq is a settlement in the municipality of Sisimiut with just over 500 inhabitants. It is the biggest international airport in Greenland and the hub of traffic to and from the entire West Coast.

The area is famous for its large population of musk oxen and for its proximity to the ice cap. As the only place in Greenland, there is a dirt track all the way to the ice cap, enabling 4 wheel drive excursions to the ice cap. The Kangerlussuaq Airport can accommodate even the largest planes, and if you wish to have a pax exchange in Greenland this is the place to have it.

**Location:** 66°57'06"N / 50°03'03"W

**Ice condition:** Ice free June-December

**No pier**

**Safe anchorage:** 66°57'06"N / 50°58'03"W

**Tender point:** pontoon at the harbour about 30 mins bus ride from the airport and settlement.

**Recommended max pax:** 2000

**Recommended duration of call:** for pax exchange calculate 2 hrs/200 pax

**Please note:** that we charge 20% extra for handling operations that start or finish between 1600 and 0700 due to new regulations from the Greenland Airport Authorities

**Transfer services:** Transfer services including luggage handling offered. Special barges for transport of luggage from ship to quay, lorry



### Transfer to/from ship:

**Duration:** Approx 30 min/one way harbor to airport

**Max pax/trip:** 200 passengers in one take

### By 4-Wheel-Drive to the Inland Ice:

Drive the 40 kilometers to the icecap in specially outfitted 4 WDs through a scenic and breathtaking landscape. Experience the enormous ice desert and take the possibility to walk on the icecap.

### Musk Oxen Safari:

One of the main attractions in Kangerlussuaq is the approx. 7000 musk oxen, which can be found in the area. This tour offers a chance to see them up close.

The tour can be made in connection with a pax transfer, starting at the harbour and ending up at the airport terminal building or vice versa or as an excursion which starts and ends at the ship.
